1 静安寺

一座比上海市建成更早的佛教寺庙，其历史相传最早可追溯至公元247年，是上海最古老的佛寺。它标志性的金屋顶，也让它的建筑风格和观赏价值变得极为鲜明。

2 玉佛寺

距离酒店步行10分钟即可到达，因寺内主要供奉玉佛而得名。玉佛寺作为上海旅游的十大景点之一，它虽地处繁华的市区，却又闹中取静，被喻为闹市中的一片净土。

3 鸿寿坊

距离酒店步行10分钟即可到达。典型的二层砖木结构石库门里弄住宅，极具中国与上海独特的建筑风格。不仅满足游客们的观赏需求，也丰富了美食购物体验，堪称“一站式旅行目的地”。

4 M50创意园

由纺织厂转变为“艺术家聚集地”的创意艺术园区，保留了上世纪的工业建筑。您可以在这里欣赏到历史建筑、个性涂鸦、各类艺术创造品以及沿途的苏州河迷人风光。

5 馨和小馆(本帮菜餐厅)

长寿路商圈本帮菜热门榜第1名。它以代表性的上海烹饪、平易近人的价格和实惠正宗的口味，受到了无数本地市民的认可和青睐，成为了本地人们日常饮食或招待亲友的上佳之选。

6 汉服体验和拍摄馆

您可以在这里找到许多更为贴近真实历史的复原款汉服。您可以仅租借服装以沉浸式地探索上海，也可以选择购买摄影服务为这次旅行留下一份特殊的回忆。

7 苏州河

苏州河流经上海市内的大部分区域，是上海市民生活的重要组成部分之一。两岸的风景和建筑，见证了这座城市的历史变迁，承载着无数的人文故事，是探索文化脉搏的必打卡地。



8 京都一乘寺拉面豚人(日式拉面馆)

以极为浓郁的汤底而闻名的日式拉面馆，经过长时间熬煮的骨汤牢牢地挂在面条之上，适合重口味拉面的爱好者和喜欢鲜香厚重口味的食客，无数“美食家们”纷纷排队品尝。

9 Herbar·Shisha Bar

隐藏在创享塔创意园区中的一家清吧，以其独特的花园氛围和优雅意境，以及独具灵感的高颜值特调鸡尾酒为滋养，在这座历史悠久的建筑中绽放出簇簇繁花。

10 南京路步行街

上海最著名的商业街，被誉为“中华商业第一街”，横跨黄浦、静安两区，是购物、观光和体验海派文化的热目的地。南京东路以传统步行街、游客观光和大众消费为主，而南京西路则奢侈商场、高楼大厦林立，以高端购物为特色。

11 上海城隍庙

上海市著名传统景点之一，供奉敕封上海城隍神秦裕伯，是道教正一派的宫观，与老城隍庙小吃、荷花池、湖心亭及九曲桥组成了独具特色的上海“老城厢”旅游文化名片。

12 宫宴

在中国传统历史文化表演中享受美食，通过一餐美味全面地感受和欣赏中华文化、礼仪，甚至是历史故事。建议提前预约和租借汉服，融入场景，获得更加沉浸式的旅行体验。

13 上海外滩建筑群

上海历史文化和美学价值最高的近代建筑群体，是上海城市的象征，承载着上海近200年的历史、经济和文化的变迁，有着“万国建筑博览会”之美誉。

14 东方明珠广播电视塔 & 陆家嘴

东方明珠广播电视塔与隔江的外滩万国建筑博览群交相辉映，陆家嘴则是上海国际金融中心的核心功能区，其中的三座超摩天大楼更被世界各地的游客列为必去打卡地之一，并称呼它们为“魔都三件套”。

15 上海电影博物馆

前身为上海电影制片厂原址，是国内规模最大的电影行业博物馆。融展示与互动、参观与体验为一体，呈现了百年上海电影的魅力，生动演绎了电影人、电影事和其背后的故事。

16 上海博物馆

馆内收藏了包括青铜器、陶器等31个品类的涵盖实证中华优秀传统文化的珍贵文物，是收藏中国古代艺术品最全的博物馆之一，为游客们提供了探索国家文化遗产的深刻之旅。

17 上海动物园

紧邻上海虹桥国际机场，园内住着具有“国宝”和“活化石”之称的大熊猫，以及中国特产珍稀野生动物和世界各地的代表性动物近500种。

1 Jing'an Temple

A golden beacon since 247 AD, Jing'an Temple's roofs now shine in Shanghai's skyline, revealing the spiritual heart beneath the modern city.

2 Jade Buddha Temple

Just 10 minutes away, the Jade Buddha Temple offers a serene retreat with exquisite jade statues and a glimpse into Shanghai's cultural soul.

3 Hongshou Fang

10 minutes from our hotel, Hongshou Fang blends heritage shikumen architecture with modern charm for an immersive taste of local life.

4 M50 Creative Park

Once a textile mill, this creative art hub has preserved its industrial architecture from the last century. Here you can admire historic buildings, expressive graffiti, diverse art creations, and the charming scenery of Suzhou Creek.

5 Xinhe Restaurant (Authentic Shanghai Cuisine)

Ranked NO.1 for Shanghai cuisine in the Changshou Road business district, this beloved local spot offers representative dishes at affordable prices, winning the hearts of residents for daily meals and family gatherings.

6 Traditional Chinese Clothing Experience & Photo Studio

Discover "Hanfu", traditional Chinese attire that authentically reflects ancient Chinese culture. You can rent the garments for an immersive exploration of Shanghai or book a photography session to create lasting memories of your journey.

7 Suzhou Creek

Flowing through the heart of Shanghai, Suzhou Creek serves as the city's living cultural artery, where daily life and architectural heritage unfold along its peaceful banks.

8 Kyoto Ichijoji Ramen Tonjin (Japanese Ramen Restaurant)

Famous for its intensely rich broth that clings perfectly to every noodle, this Japanese ramen restaurant draws food lovers craving deep savory flavors and is a must try for those who enjoy bold, hearty bowls.



9 Herbar-Shisha Bar

Tucked away in the X Tower Creative Park, this refined lounge offers a unique garden ambience and an air of quiet elegance, where inspired, artfully crafted cocktails bloom like flowers within the historic walls.

10 Nanjing Road Walkway

Known as China's premier shopping street, Nanjing Road stretches across Huangpu and Jing'an districts, offering a vibrant mix of sightseeing, retail, and Haipai culture. East Nanjing Road is a classic pedestrian strip bustling with tourists and accessible shops, while West Nanjing Road impresses with luxury malls and skyscrapers for an upscale experience.

11 Shanghai City God Temple

Dedicated to Qin Yubo, the revered guardian deity of Shanghai, this Zhengyi Daoist temple forms a vibrant cultural destination together with the Old City God Temple snack street, Lotus Pond, Mid-Lake Pavilion and the Nine-Bend Bridge, presenting the authentic charm of Shanghai's old town.

12 GONGYAN Royal Banquet

Enjoy an immersive dining experience accompanied by traditional Chinese historical and cultural performances, including music, dance and ritual, all while savoring a feast that brings China's heritage to life. Advance reservation and Hanfu rental are recommended to fully immerse yourself in the scene.

13 The Bund Historic Architecture

As Shanghai's most iconic architectural ensemble, the Bund embodies nearly two centuries of the city's historical, economic, and cultural evolution. Known as the "Exposition of World Architecture", it remains a powerful symbol of Shanghai's enduring legacy.

14 Oriental Pearl Tower & Lujiazui

The Oriental Pearl Tower beautifully complements the historic Bund across the river, while Lujiazui serves as the core hub of Shanghai's international finance district. Its three towering skyscrapers, nicknamed the "Magic City Trio" by visitors from around the world, have become unmissable landmarks.

15 Shanghai Film Museum

Originally the site of the former Shanghai Film Studio, this is the largest museum dedicated to China's film industry. Blending displays with interactive experiences, it presents the charm of a century of Shanghai cinema and brings to life the stories of the filmmakers and their craft behind the screen.

16 Shanghai Museum

Home to over 31 categories of precious artifacts including ancient bronzes and ceramics, the Shanghai Museum houses one of China's most comprehensive collections of classical art, offering a profound journey through the nation's cultural heritage.

17 Shanghai Zoo

Located conveniently near Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (SHA), the zoo is home to nearly 500 animal species, including the national treasure giant panda, rare endemic wildlife of China, and representative creatures from around the world.
